



CARGO SCREENING REQUIREMENTS

Effective 3rd February 2009

Due to new Transportation Security Administration (TSA) regulations we are required to obtain written authorisation from air freight exporters to perform x-ray screening and/or physical and visual screening of all air freight received into our warehouses in the USA.

Genesis Forwarding Services must therefore receive and retain a one time authorisation letter from all shippers. A draft letter is attached which must be completed on your company letter head then signed and returned to us. Without this consent we are not permitted by the TSA to collect or ship your air freight consignments. You may continue to provide individual authorisation to screen your cargo by signing each individual Shipper's Letter of Instruction (SLI) attached until such time as we receive your blanket letter.

We are further instructed by the TSA that all Indirect Air Carriers (IAC) approved by the TSA are not permitted to disclose the flight number of the aircraft to shippers until after departure of the flight or, in the case of transshipments the final sector. As an approved IAC we will of course continue to provide you with other commercial information relating to your shipment such as airwaybill numbers, airline name and date of flight.

Since we will be incurring additional costs for screening and security the following fee will apply
\$0.15 per kilo weight, minimum \$15.00
